Pursuant to Cooperative Service Agreement No. 08-7308-5358-RA between the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Inspection Service, Wildlife Services (APHIS-WS) and Denver International Airport (DIA), Denver, CO; this Work Plan defines the objectives, plan of action, and budget for the Wildlife Services program to be conducted beginning July 1, 2010 and continuing through June 30, 2011.

To implement the FAA-approved Wildlife Hazard Management Plan (WHMP) addressing wildlife hazards observed during data collection of the airport and vicinity at DIA.

To monitor wildlife activity and provide recommendations to reduce hazards to aircraft operations, provide wildlife hazard management training to airport personnel, assist in habitat modification needs, wildlife population management and mitigation measures to minimize present and future wildlife strike hazards.

To alleviate threats to Human Health and Safety (HHS) on airport property as related to hazardous nuisance wildlife.
