**In accordance with the 1998 Landfill Agreement and XO 115, the City is required to dispose of all waste materials at DADS. The City has a one-year contract with WMC that set the rates for the City’s disposal of waste material at DADS and WMC’s trash transfer stations that will expire on December 31, 2010. This ordinance seeks approval of an amendment to that contract under which the Term would be extended for two months at higher disposal fees, while the City and WMC negotiate the Term of the next contract.**
