6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

The proposed ordinance is for approval of an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with UDFCD regarding final design, rightof-way acquisition and construction of drainage and flood control improvements along First Creek at East 56th Avenue in Denver. The purpose of the project is to realign the flood plain to prevent flooding of 56th Avenue during major events, minimize the cost of light rail bridge construction, and maximize developable area for private land owners.
