**A BILL**

For an Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 426, Series of 2007, as amended by Ordinance Number 335, Series of 2009, Ordinance Number 148, Series of 2010, Ordinance Number 11, Series of 2011, Ordinance Number 191, Series of 2011, Ordinance Number 258, Series of 2011, Ordinance Number 630, Series of 2011, Ordinance Number 63, Series of 2013, Ordinance Number 73, Series of 2014, Ordinance Number 376, Series of 2014, and Ordinance Number 738, Series of 2014 designating the project to be undertaken and funded with the proceeds of the Better Denver bonds.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and Council designate the following projects and level of funding to be undertaken with the proceeds of the general obligation bonds authorized by voters at the November 6, 2007 election, as such debt is authorized, or may be authorized in the future, by the Mayor and Council.
