BHSC Program Overview

- Voluntary safe haven for adults experiencing a behavioral health crisis
- Critical short-term care and treatment
- Diverts individuals from unwarranted/ unnecessary stays in inappropriate facilities, such as the emergency department or jail

Unique Individuals Served Annually by Component, 2021 (May) – 2024*




