Scope of Work

955 E. 51st Avenue

H & L Concrete, Inc. intends to utilize the City's vacant lot as a temporary staging yard during construction of the Globeville Levee project.

The staging area will be used for storing and staging construction equipment and materials. A construction trailer will also be placed onsite for project personnel.

Prior to moving equipment and materials onto the parcel, H & L Concrete will clear and level the area. The site will be fenced to protect stored equipment. At the completion of the project, all excess materials, equipment, and fencing will be removed, and the area will be restored to a graded and stabilized condition and to any additional requirements specified by the Department of Transportation & Infrastructure.
