Mile High 360 is a community-based nonprofit that empowers first generation postsecondary bound students with long-term, year-round access to essential Out of School Time (OST) resources and opportunities. With support from HFDK funding, Mile High 360 will provide direct nutritious food access for families in the form of food boxes and daily meals for students aged 18-years and under. Mile High 360 will also provide application assistance with federal nutrition assistance programs, student cooking classes, nutrition workshops, and family cooking classes. Mile High 360 will contribute to HFDK Priority Area 1: Nutritious Food Access and Security by providing monthly food boxes (1 x per month for 10 months out of the year), daily nutritious and culturally relevant meals for students aged 18-years and under, and hands-on gardening education. Mile High 360 will contribute to Priority Area 2: Increasing Participation in Federal Nutrition Assistance Programs through providing information and application assistance with federal nutrition assistance programs through a bilingual family liaison. Mile High 360 will support Priority Area 3: Food and Nutrition Education through providing student cooking classes in partnership with Slow Food Denver, nutrition workshops facilitated by internal staff members, and free virtual family cooking classes taught in collaboration with chefs from Bonanno Concepts three times per year.
