BR12- Extends the \$165,000 lease with Air General's Support Facilities for 0271 space for the British Airways cargo handler through the end of 2012 (AR 56027-02).

BR12- Approves a purchase request for three Fire Fighting F550 Patrol units at 0272 a total cost of \$687,691.00 (00156584).

Government & Finance

BR12- Extends the lease with Colorado Studios for Denver 8 at the Stapleton 0267 location through the end of 2012 for \$130,901.36 while the new Denver 8 space located in the City and County Building is completed (CE73018-6).

BR12- Approves a \$2,027,590 contract with Steer Davies Gleave to prepare a

Analysis for the East Colfax Corridor, with a \$1,358,485 FTA grant and
12% DSBO goal exceeded at 21%, in Council Districts 5, 8 and 10.
