5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

- Original Ordinance No 42, Series 2008 stated that the required applicant match would be provided by a donation from the Target Corporation in the amount of \$100,250; and, that the balance of the required match would be provided by the Denver Property Confiscation Fund (12010-0405101-S1027FEDERAL) in the amount of \$100,000.
- Correction to the allocation is needed as follows. A donation in the amount of \$100,000 was provided by the Target Corporation (reference CP683414 12/07/2007); and, the balance of the required match of \$100,250 has been provided by the Denver Property Confiscation Fund (reference award 07C-150).
- No change to the federal portion of the grant award, or the overall grant amount of \$400,500 would result from this ordinance request.
