 - a. Scope of Work**

To assist the Denver Office of HIV Resources (DOHR) in processing reimbursement billings from sub-recipient agencies approved by DOHR. The contractor will assist DOHR in processing reimbursement billings as verified and approved by DOHR. The Colorado Nonprofit Development Center will act as the fiscal agent for the city of the Ryan White CARE Act Part A funding (not to exceed \$8,500,000) received from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services through the Health Resources & Services Administration. The Colorado Nonprofit Development Center and the Ryan White CARE Act Part A funds enables the Denver Office of HIV Resources to conduct its work in procuring services for persons living with HIV/AIDS, as well as cover administrative and oversight costs to run the program. The program is entirely funded with federal dollars. The contractor will be paid \$20,000.00 to provide the above mentioned services for DOHR.
