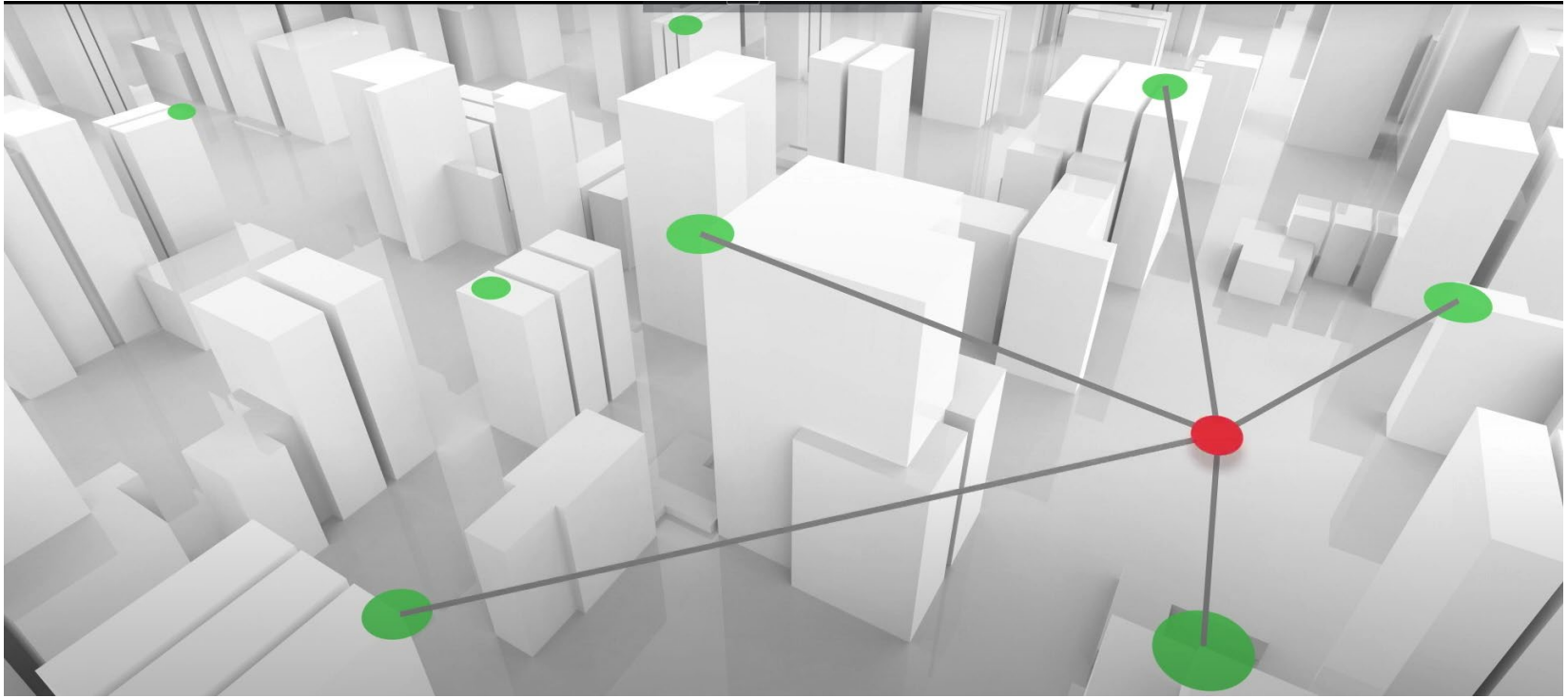

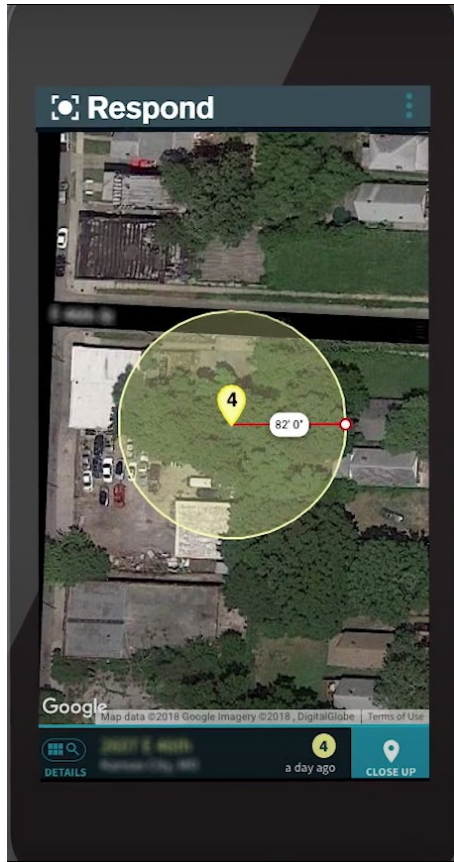

How ShotSpotter Works



Sensors throughout the coverage areas detect and locate the sounds of gunfire

Published Gunfire Alerts



- Alerts are reviewed and published to our officers within 45-60 seconds of the gunfire
- ShotSpotter Insight is used by:
 - Patrol Officers
 - Analysts
 - Detectives
 - Command Staff

ShotSpotter Data

Key Impacts:

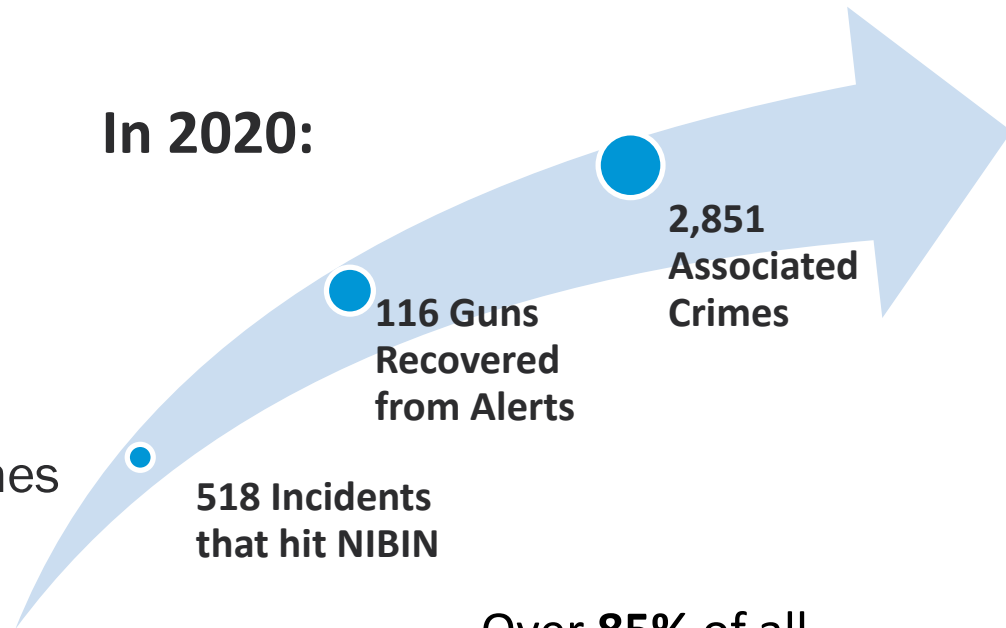
- Awareness of crime
- Safety
- Potential for future gunfire cases

Without ShotSpotter:

- Decreased response to gun crimes
- Decreased case clearance

Gun crime and access to firearms continues to plague our community, especially our marginalized populations.

In 2020:



Over **85%** of all ShotSpotter detections had no correlating 911 call.

Responding Rapidly to Victims

Oct, 2016 – District 2

- Two juveniles shot
- No accompanying 911 call
- Officers found one deceased but were able to provide rapid aid to the second, saving his life
- Alerts were instrumental in piecing together events of the night

May, 2020 – District 1

- Middle-aged man shot multiple times
- No accompanying 911 call
- Quickly rushed to Denver Health where treating physicians stated our rapid response saved his life

Amendment

- Amends the contract between CCD and ShotSpotter, Inc.
- Provides approximately 14 miles coverage area
 - This does not add coverage area
- Includes:
 - Gunfire Detection, Location, Alert and Analysis equipment and services to DPD
- Adds an additional year through 12/31/2021
 - Adds an appropriation of \$835,438 for a contract total of \$4,526,392
 - Paid for through grant funding and general funds

Amendment

- ShotSpotter Respond is a cloud-based, subscription managed service with:
 - warranty, repair, maintenance, and support services on all of its systems
- Includes web-based ShotSpotter Dispatch, ShotSpotter Respond, and ShotSpotter Insight applications
