A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to and an appropriation in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS, in 2020, Denver voters approved Referred Measure 2A, which increased the sales tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2021 to be spent on various programs and projects that address climate change; and

WHEREAS, an allowable use of revenues for the Climate Protection Program includes capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 21-1212, Series of 2021, established the Climate Protection Capital Projects Fund in the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund Series to receive transfers from the Climate Protection Fund and administer capital projects that support climate initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer funds from the Climate Protection SRF to the Climate Protection Capital Projects Fund to support solar infrastructure and electrified mobility capital projects and to support other city agencies to supplement projects that advance Denver's climate goals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the General Government Special Revenue Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund:
