

## Proclamation No. 13-0335

## Celebrating the 18<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Juniper Village - The Spearly Center in Denver

**WHEREAS**, Juniper Communities was founded in 1988 by Lynne S. Katzmann and is located at 2205 West 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Denver, Colorado, and is celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year; and

WHEREAS, Juniper Communities acquired Juniper Village – The Spearly Center - in 1995 and the center is celebrating its 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year; and

**WHEREAS,** Juniper Village – The Spearly Center is home to approximately 135 residents and 140 professionals dedicated to providing person-centered care in a therapeutic community; and

**WHEREAS,** Juniper Village - The Spearly Center serves people living with chronic mental illness, brain injury, or neurological disorders providing a wide range of care and services to include respite care, short-term rehabilitation, skilled nursing assistance, and long-term residency; and

**WHEREAS,** Juniper Village - The Spearly Center provides a holistic approach to care by involving the individual and his/her care team to create a plan of care that addresses the person's physical, emotional, spiritual, cognitive, social occupational, relationship, and leisure pursuit toward well-being in each realm of life; and

**WHEREAS,** Juniper Village – The Spearly Center actively supports National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Walks, and has a long-standing relationship with the Brain Injury Alliance of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, Juniper Village – The Spearly Center actively participates in programs offered in the Denver area with its residents including the Adaptive Skiing Program sponsored by the Breckinridge Outdoor Education Center; visitations by the Denver Broncos Cheerleaders; and the Denver Regional Council of Governments.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

**Section 1.** That the Denver City Council recognizes Juniper Village - The Spearly Center on its 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary and congratulates the center and its employees for providing a safe-haven of specialized care to maximize recovery, healing, and long-term assistance to Denver residents.

**Section 2.** That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to Sue Pappas, NHA, Juniper Village – The Spearly Center.
