

## Proclamation No. CP-11-0150

Recognizing the Denver St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee for its 49th Annual Parade on March 12, 2011

**WHEREAS**, the first St. Patrick's Day Parade ever was held in Boston in 1737, and now Denver stages one of the largest parades west of the Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, this year, the theme for the St. Patrick's parade, "Forever Green 2011", pays tribute to Colorado's natural beauty and gives a tip o' the hat to the nonprofit organization, Alpine Rescue Team with member Roz Brown as Grand Marshall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parade will step off at Blake and 27<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed on Blake Street to 20<sup>th</sup> Street featuring Queen Colleen 2011 Ms. Keriayn O'Donnell and Court, accompanied by 10,000 participants in 230 units, showcasing pipe and drums, Irish step dancers, clowns and colorful floats; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 10 at 3:30 PM, Mayor Vidal will oversee the annual changing o' the street name signs at 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Wazee to read "Tooley Street" for the St. Patrick's celebration; and

**WHEREAS**, amidst all the celebration, we do want to note the passing of Walt Beckert, a long-time member of the Denver St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee and a well-loved City employee who devoted many years to Denver's youth through his work with the Safe City program; and

**WHEREAS,** Denver's St. Patrick's Day Parade is a worthy example of how thousands of diverse people come together for a nod at the past and in anticipation of the future on a day when everyone can be Irish; and

**WHEREAS,** the Colorado sun and Mile High air lifts the spirits of all spectators on Saturday March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011, we hope a warm wind will be at all our backs. We hope all will share in celebrating the St. Patrick's Day Parade, "Forever Green 2011".

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

**Section 1.** That the Council hereby congratulates the volunteer Denver St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee on another well-organized event; wishes for sunshine and the wind to be at the back of all, and hopes for another peaceful yet spirited gathering at the 49th annual event.

**Section 2.** That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to the Denver St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee and "Sam" Kervin.
