A BILL

For an ordinance amending Section 18-81, D.R.M.C., setting the salaries of elected officers for terms beginning July 15, 2019

WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution and Charter of the City and County of Denver prohibit the salaries of elected officials from being increased or decreased during a term of office; and

WHEREAS, section 9.2.2 of the charter requires the City Council to establish the salaries for the ensuing term of elected Charter officers after January 1 of each year in which a general city election will be held, but before the general election; and

WHEREAS, any increase in the salaries of elected officials is limited to the cumulative increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI or the cumulative increase in the mean salary of employees in the Career Service, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the cumulative increase in the Denver-Aurora-Lakewood CPI during the period 2015 through 2018, inclusive, was 10.07%; and

WHEREAS, as reported by the Office of Human Resources, the cumulative increase in the mean salary of employees in the Career Service for the period 2015 through 2018, inclusive, was 12.67%, meaning that the annual salaries of Denver elected officials cannot increase in excess of 10.07% during the next four-year term of the elected officials commencing July 15, 2019.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That section 18-81, D.R.M.C. is amended by deleting the language stricken and

1 adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

3 **Sec. 18-81. Salaries.**

4 In accordance with the limitations on the salaries of elected Charter officers as set forth in
5 section 9.2.2 of the Charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries for the term beginning ~~July~~
