A BILL

For an Ordinance approving a proposed donation of a surplus vehicle from the City and County of Denver to the nonprofit entity Bayaud Enterprises, Inc.

WHEREAS, the proposed donation of surplus vehicle from the City and County of Denver to the nonprofit entity Bayaud Enterprises, Inc. cannot be made until after approval action by the Council of the City in accordance with section 12.3.9 of the Charter of the City because, under the terms of the proposed donation, the City will donate one surplus vehicle to Bayaud Enterprises, Inc. for the purpose of assisting it in providing transportation, outreach, recruitment, and other job readiness services to homeless individuals served through the Denver Day Works program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has duly reviewed and approved the proposed donation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Subject to availability, the proposed donation by the City of one vehicle to Bayaud Enterprises, Inc., to assist it in providing transportation, outreach, recruitment, and other job readiness services to homeless individuals, is hereby approved.
