5	county court magistrates in the county court. Except as otherwise provided in section 18-11 and in this
6	section, every such employee shall be paid biweekly at a biweekly rate arrived at by dividing the
7	annual rate set forth in part (b) of this section by the biweekly periods for the calendar year.
