The ordinance request seeks to appropriate \$1,250,000 of funding associated with the fully executed agreement (DOTI-202159332-00) with Mile High Flood District (Urban Drainage and Flood Control District). The agreement committed \$1,250,000 in Mile High Flood District (UDFCD) funds and \$1,250,000 in DOTI-Wastewater Enterprise funds (previously appropriated) for the Marston Lakes North at Bowles Ditch project to construct drainage and flood control improvements totaling \$2,500,000. This project is being managed through design by the MHFD (UDFCD) and will be constructed by DOTI. The City shall be reimbursed with Mile High Flood District funds after construction is complete.
