6 7 8	For an ordinance amending subsections 20-63 (a) and (b), D.R.M.C., concerning the threshold dollar limits for Formal and Informal bidding levels.

9 WHEREAS, the current bidding threshold levels were set in 1996, and increases in the 10 Consumer Price Index reveal that the cost of goods since 1996 have increased by nearly fifty 11 percent (50%), and after review the Auditor's office has suggested an increase in the current 12 levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That subsections (a) and (b) of section 20-63, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by striking the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and replacing it with Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) as follows:

- 18 Sec. 20-63. Bidding procedures.
- 19 (a) Formal procedure. Formal advertisement by official publication shall precede the 20 issuance of any bidder's proposal or request for proposal estimated to amount to twentyfive thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or more. Such 21 advertisement shall specify the supplies or services to be purchased or refer to the 22 23 standards and specifications established pursuant to this division and shall state the 24 amount of the bond, if any, required. If formal advertisement is not practicable, bids or proposals shall be requested from at least three (3) responsible bidders or proposers 25 26 dealing in the supplies, equipment or personal property required. All bids or proposals in 27 response to advertisements or requests by the city shall be submitted, in sealed form, 28 delivered to the office of the manager of general services or to any location as may be 29 from time to time determined by the manager of general services as the "bid opening" 30 location" or the "proposal acceptance location" and shall be publicly opened at the time specified in the advertisement of notice or request of the city. The auditor or his or her 31 32 representative may be present and inspect all bids. All bidders may be present and, after examination and tabulation, the results shall be subject to inspection by competing 33

bidders. In the case of requests for proposals, proposers may be present for the receipt
of proposals by the city, but may not inspect proposals until an award has been made.

Informal procedure: Any bidder's proposal or request for proposal for supplies or 3 (b) 4 services which is estimated to amount to less than twenty-five (\$25,000.00) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) may be by informal procedure upon notice calculated to 5 inform potential bidders in a manner that will achieve maximum competition among 6 bidders and maximum economy to the city. However, no bidder's proposal or request for 7 8 proposal or purchase may be subdivided to avoid the requirements of subsection (a) or 9 any other provision of this division. Informal procedures do not require advertising, 10 receipt of bids or proposals in a sealed form or a public bid or proposal opening or 11 acceptance.
