**A BILL**

**For an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 9.1.1 (C) and (D) of the Charter and Article I of Chapter 18, D.R.M.C., the Career Service Authority has recommended to the City Council an amendment to the classification and pay plan governing the compensation of employees in the career service and certain employees not in the career service;

**WHEREAS**, a restructuring of the Short Range and Community Rate pay schedules is required due to an increase in the State of Colorado’s minimum wage rate from \$7.36 per hour to \$7.64 per hour effective January 1, 2012.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2012.

**Section 2.** The classification and pay plan is hereby amended by changing the pay grade associated with certain job titles to read as follows:

<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Old Pay Grade</u>	<u>New Pay Grade</u>
Collections Investigator	614-N	616-N
Recreational Facility Assistant	220-Y	219-Y
Park Seasonal Laborer	226-Y	225-Y

**Section 3.** That the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by re-structuring the schedules for the Community Rate and Short Range pay tables.

**Section 4.** That the foregoing amendments shall be reflected in the full classification and pay plan kept and maintained in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, as reflected at Clerk Filing No. 11-330-I, and at the Career Service Authority, and shall be available for public inspection both in person and on-line.
