- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
  - a. Scope of Work

    The proposed ordinance will create a 3 tier Occupational Privilege Tax registration fee as follows:
    - \$0 fee: For businesses that owed less than \$30 in combined employee and business occupational privilege tax in the 12 months prior to the registration year.
    - \$25 fee: For individuals, sole proprietors and partnerships with no employees subject to the occupational privilege tax and that pay the opt liability in advance annually (these businesses are liable for only the \$4 business opt each month). This cuts the fee in half for up to an additional 7,000 to 8,000 small businesses (if OPT is paid in advance).
    - \$50 fee: For all other businesses.
