6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

The City applied for and was granted an FTA Alternatives analysis grant in the amount of \$2,000,000 through a national competitive funding process in 2010. The project will analyze transit alternatives to meet a 20 – 30% increase in person-trip demand in the East Colfax corridor by 2030. The existing transit and roadway corridor is currently at capacity for much of the day. The FTA grant will be used to evaluate the new generation transportation demand model, Focus, developed by DRCOG for the region. This ordinance will establish a contract with AECOM
