Type of services, include but are not limited to cognitive skill training, case management, emergency transitional housing, limited public transportation, benefit and ID acquisition, employment readiness, placement and coaching, access to educational supports such as a GED, family reunification and parenting, healthy living skills, substance abuse treatment readiness and treatment as possible, access to trauma management as possible, computer skills and access to community resources and supportive services.

This contract provides for a one-year agreement extension (CY2014) that cumulatively exceeds the threshold contained in Section 3.2.6(E) of the Charter requiring City Council approval. The proposed one-year amendment cost is \$543,283.50 and the total cumulative cost since 2013 are \$1,001,128.32.
