5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

Request budget appropriation of \$682,400 for the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) based on a letter of intent from the State of Colorado Department of Local Affairs. The total award estimate is \$853,000, and DHS is requesting to establish a budget for 80 percent of the total forecasted award.

The Community Services Block Grant is a well-established, ongoing grant program with a long track record of having been awarded to Denver Human Services (DHS). CSBG is a non-competitive federal funding allocation from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, distributed by the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) and administered by local entities, including the City and County of Denver. DHS uses the funding to support Denver-based projects that reduce poverty, revitalize low-income communities, and empower people living at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. The 2025 Community Services Block grant continues to fund providers that provide employment support, housing stabilization, and linking individuals and families to essential support services. Establishing a 2026 budget will facilitate the continuity of service provision.
