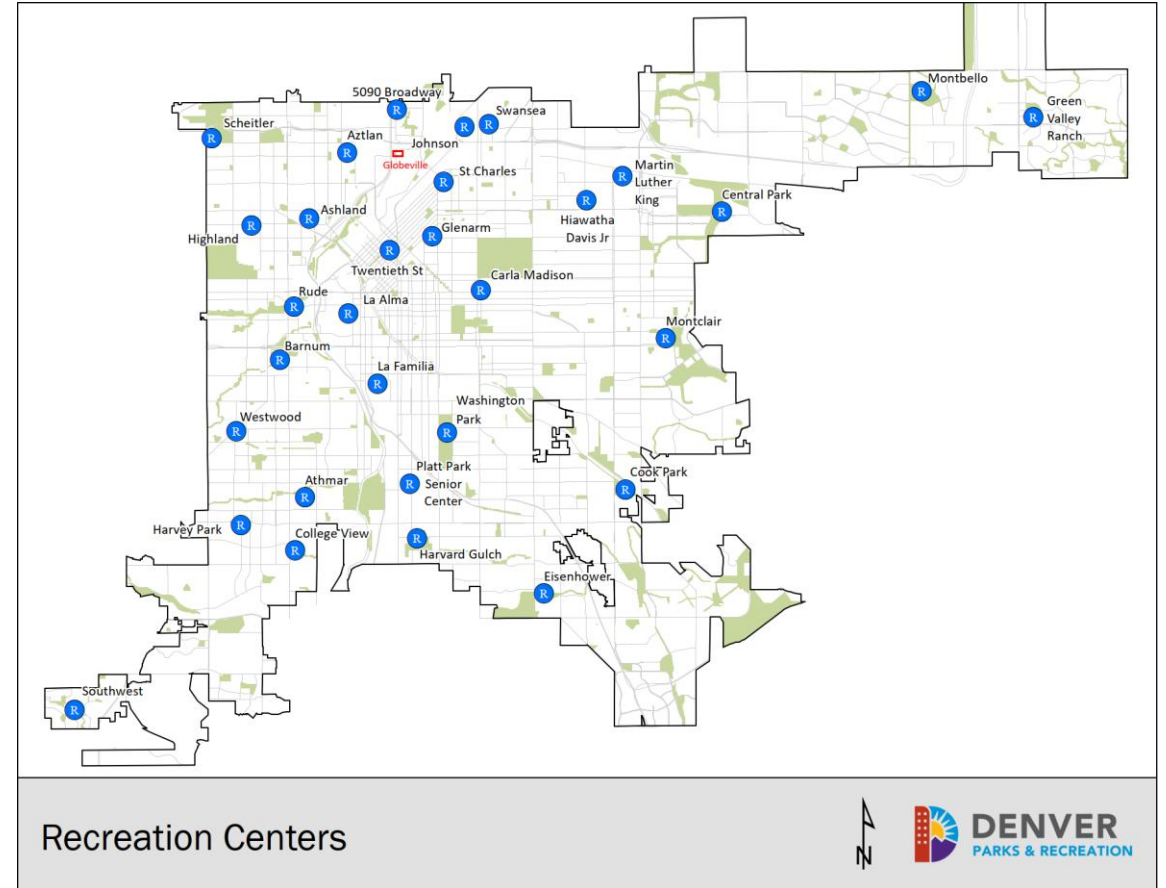
COUNCIL RESOLUTION 26-0471

- Approves a use agreement between the City of Denver and Denver Dream Center for \$90,000.00 and for three years to occupy and provide programming at the former Globeville Recreation Center at 4496 Grant St., in Council District 9.



RECREATION CENTERS

- Denver Parks and Recreation operates 30 recreation centers in all of Denver
- In 2010, programming by third party at three recreation Johnson, College View and Globeville
- Globeville Community Center continues to be programmed outside of Recreation
- Previous agreement ended fall 2025



REQUEST FOR PARTICIPATION (RFP) PROCESS

- Previous 2017 RFP with community input was the base for this RFP
- Utilization and activation of building through programming for a variety of ages, including arts & culture, team sports, social enrichment, fitness, summer camps, after-school activities, meals, food assistance, field trips, tutoring, outdoor recreation, environmental education, health & wellness, job assistance, language assistance, social services, will be proposed relevant to the community needs and wants.
- Published July 1, 2025
- Closed August 28, 2025
- 3 responses
- Scored by 3 DPR Staff – Recreation Directors and Administrative Staff

TERM AGREEMENTS

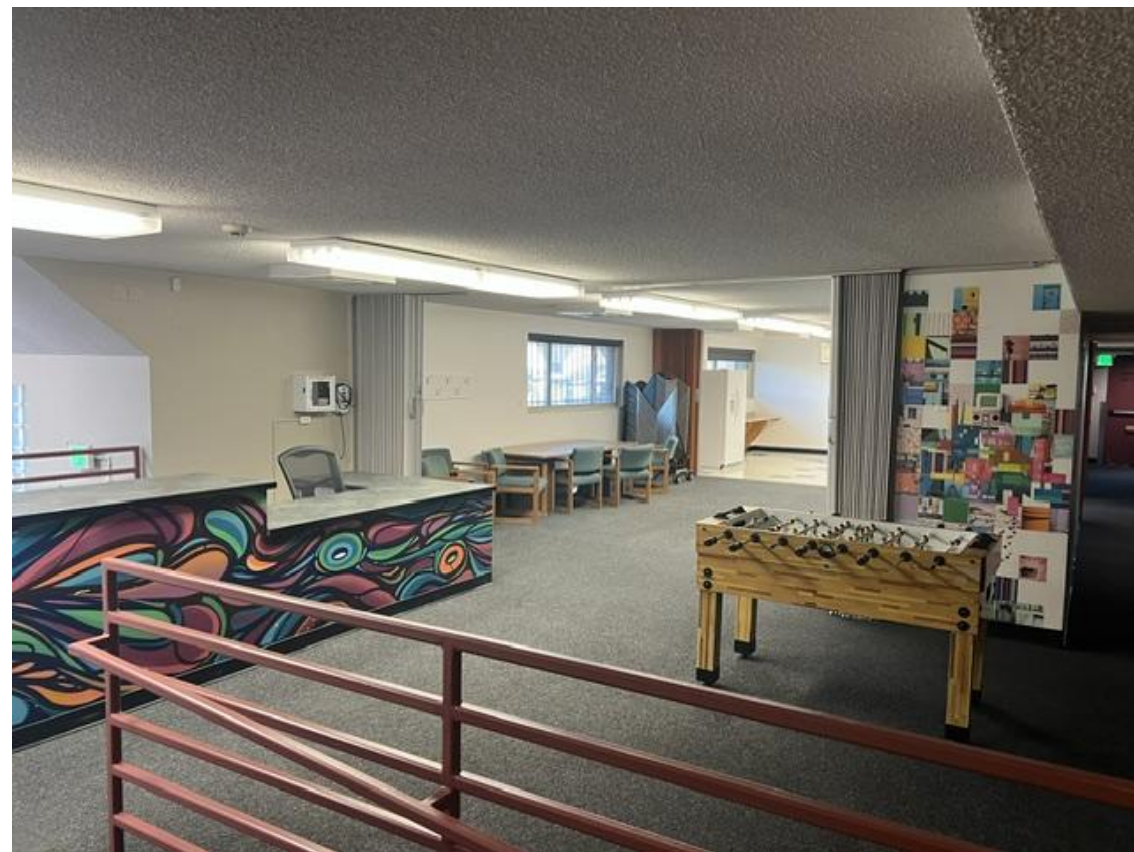
- Three years from date of execution
- Payments
 - 2026: \$24,000
 - 2027: \$30,000
 - 2028: \$36,000
- 95 hours recreation center will be open and programmed, with extended hours on Friday and Saturday nights
- Scheduled activities will maximize facility use, with year-round operation

POTENTIAL PROGRAMMING

- **Youth Programs:**
 - Resource distribution - food, clothing;
 - Enrichment activities; After School tutoring and mentoring
 - Youth Sports and sports camp
 - Youth Nights on weekends
 - Art experiences,
- **Adult Programs:**
 - Job assistance and financial literacy workshops
 - Fitness and wellness classes
 - Parenting support groups
 - Cultural events
- **Senior Programs:**
 - Low impact exercise like chair yoga
 - Social clubs and games
 - Educational/tech classes
 - Resource outings
