8 **For an ordinance amending Section 18-81, D.R.M.C., setting the salaries of elected**
9 **officers for terms beginning July 17, 2023.**
10

11 WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution and Charter of the City and County of Denver
12 prohibit the salaries of elected officials from being increased or decreased during a term of
13 office; and

14 WHEREAS, section 9.2.2 of the charter requires the City Council to establish the
15 salaries for the ensuing term of elected Charter officers after January 1 of each year in which a
16 general city election will be held, but before the general election; and

17 WHEREAS, any increase in the salaries of elected officials is limited to the cumulative
18 increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI or successor index, or the cumulative increase in
19 the mean salary of employees in the Career Service, whichever is less; and

20 WHEREAS, the cumulative increase in the Denver-Aurora-Lakewood CPI successor
21 index during the period 2019 through 2022, inclusive, was 15.42%; and

22 WHEREAS, as reported by the Office of Human Resources, the cumulative increase in
23 the mean salary of employees in the Career Service for the period 2019 through 2022,
24 inclusive, was 9.32%, meaning that the annual salaries of Denver elected officials cannot
25 increase in excess of 9.32% during the next four-year term of the elected officials commencing
26 July 17, 2023.

28 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

30 **Section 1.** That Sec. 18-81 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety
31 and the section is amended by re-enacting a new Sec. 18-81, to read as follows:

33 **Sec. 18-81. Salaries.**

34 In accordance with the limitations on the salaries of elected Charter officers as set forth in

1 section 9.2.2 of the Charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries for the term beginning July
2 17, 2023, as follows:

Officer (Elected)	Annual Salary
Mayor	\$205,990.58
Auditor	\$178,152.24
President of the Denver City Council	\$123,846.44
Members of the Denver City Council	\$110,595.76
Clerk and Recorder	\$178,152.24
