- In mid-2002 the Department of Safety requested an ordinance amending the DRMC to provide for a pay differential procedure for both civilian and sworn personnel that insured that they would not receive any less pay while on active duty than they would have received from the City if they had not been called up to serve in the Afghanistan and/or Iraqi conflicts. The language requires that the provision for pay differential cease at the end of 2010. Since the conflicts continue and City employees continue to serve in those conflicts the Department of Safety is requesting that the “sunset date” be extended to December 31, 2011.
