CDRC Capital Costs

 Programming design and detailed cost estimates for the Central Denver Recreation Center are more refined.

CDRC Supplemental Request

- Cost of construction has increased by \$6.6M.
 - Vertical design of the facility (approximately \$1.3M)
 - Dewatering/shoring, elevator stops, fire protection systems required by code, additional building skin.
 - -Escalating construction costs (\$5.3M)
 - General construction market escalation
 - Deficit to meet base programming needs 4



Supplemental Request

To address project deficit, the following sources are proposed:
