A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series for the “Human Rights and Community Partnerships Collaboration” program, rescinding budget, making an appropriation and a making a cash transfer from the Human Services Special Revenue Fund Series.

WHEREAS, there is a need for a Special Revenue Fund to facilitate financial support for collaborative projects between Human Rights and Community Partnerships and other City agencies; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 11000, a “Human Rights and Community Partnerships Collaboration” Fund, Accounting No. 11875, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

Section 2. Monies received from transfers from other City funds for Accounting No. 11875 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Human Rights and Community Partnerships Collaboration” Fund, Accounting No. 11875, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Director of the Human Rights and Community Partnerships. Allowable expenditures include those for programs and services that are tied to shared initiatives between HRCP and other City agencies. The Chief Financial Officer may transfer unused balances in the Fund to the General Fund. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.
