Purpose: This project entails conversion of the Colfax/Lipan intersection to right turns only. The median will be rebuilt in order to encourage pedestrians to utilize crosswalks, while the traffic signal will be reconstructed to accommodate the change in allowable movements and also to install a priority signal for WB buses on Colfax. Phase 1 encompasses improvements on the north side of Colfax and within the median. The type of work includes concrete paving, mill/overlay of asphalt, traffic signal construction, installation of a median including wall, and landscaping/irrigation.
