5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

This Cooperative Agreement sets forth the roles and responsibilities of all parties with regards to the operation and maintenance of the proposed Levitt Pavilion at Ruby Hill Park.

b. Duration

Friends of Levitt Pavilion Denver may use the Levitt Pavilion to put on 50 free shows and up to 5 admission based events (collectively, the "Levitt Shows") each year for 50 years. Friends of Levitt Pavilion Denver's obligation to operate and maintain the pavilion yearround for the City is subject to 5 year terms; i.e., every 5 years, the City may terminate that portion of the contract related to Friends of Levitt Pavilion Denver's year-round operation and maintenance responsibilities. Any such partial termination will not affect Friend of Levitt Pavilion Denver's right to put on the Levitt Shows for the duration of the 50-year term.
