Proclamation No. 24-0685 Honoring Our Fallen Heroes on Memorial Day

WHEREAS, Memorial Day is a solemn occasion when we come together as a community to honor the brave men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice in service to our nation; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of Denver recognizes the importance of remembering and paying tribute to those who selflessly defended our freedoms; and

WHEREAS, We stand united to express our gratitude for the valor, courage, and unwavering commitment of our fallen heroes; and

WHEREAS, Their sacrifice echoes through time, reminding us that freedom is not free, and it is our duty to ensure their memory lives on; and

WHEREAS, We gather today to honor their legacy, to lay wreaths, raise flags, and pledge our unwavering support to those who continue to serve.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Council of the City and County of Denver hereby proclaim Monday, May 27, 2024 as Memorial Day in Denver, and that all citizens are encouraged to observe this day with appropriate ceremonies and activities that honor those men and women who gave their lives while serving our country in its armed forces.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to the Post 1 Foundation.
