**CR10-0649 A resolution declaring the intent of the City and County of Denver, Colorado to issue housing revenue bonds or mortgage credit certificates to provide financing of residential facilities for low- and middle-income families or persons; prescribing certain terms and conditions of such bonds; and containing other provisions relating to the proposed issuance of such bonds. (NEIGHBORHOOD, COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)**

Approves a resolution declaring the intent of the City and County of Denver to carry forward and preserve its 2010 Private Activity Bond Volume Cap Allocation in the amount of \$27,517,905 received from the State of Colorado for allocation to Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds, Multifamily Housing Bonds, or Mortgage Credit Certificates. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 7-29-10.

Grants a revocable permit to Unipath to encroach into the public right-of-way with conduit for communications fiber optic between 6116 E. Warren Ave. and 6000 E. Evans Ave. This resolution was approved for filing at the Mayor-Council meeting on 8-3-10.

**CR10-0673 A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the city street system a parcel of land as a public alley bounded by W. 35th Ave., W. 34th Ave., N. Pecos St., N. Quivas St. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Dedicates an existing public alley bounded by W. 35th Ave., W. 34th Ave., N. Pecos St., and N. Quivas St. in Council District 9. This resolution was approved for filing at the Mayor-Council meeting on 8-3-10.

**CR10-0674 A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the city street system certain parcels of land as a public alley located at 46th Ave., between Sherman St. and Grant St. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

**CB10-0606 A bill for an ordinance relating to the Denver Zoning Code, correcting various errata. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Language Amendment No. 2 correcting various typographical and lay-out errors. PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS FOLLOWING PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-28-10.

**CB10-0607 A bill for an ordinance relating to the Denver Zoning Code, restricting growing of medical marijuana in residential districts and uses. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Language Amendment 3. Limits locations for growing medical marijuana. PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS FOLLOWING PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-28-10.

**CB10-0610 A bill for an ordinance designating the Holland House, located at 2340 South Josephine Street, as a structure for preservation. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Designates 2340 S. Josephine, Holland House, as a structure for preservation. PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST ONE WEEK FOLLOWING PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-28-10.

**Bond Implementation**

**CB10-0639 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Haselden Construction, LLC and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Amends the on-call contract with Haselden Construction, LLC for the Denver Fire Department boiler replacement for a maximum task amount of \$429,948.00. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**CB10-0642 A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between Goodland Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for the Babi Yar Park Improvements Project. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Approves a contract with Goodland Construction for bond-financed improvements at Babi Yar Park to reduce long-term maintenance, including renovation of pathways, water features, monuments; historic bridge restoration and abutment stabilization; and berming along Havana edge and Yale streetscape edge. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**Economic Development**

**CB10-0629 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Third Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Simat Helliesen & Eichner, Inc. concerning professional and technical services at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Adds \$400,000 and extends the contract with Simat Helliesen & Eichner, Inc. for five years for air service development, industry research and impact studies and mobile technology to market airport concessions and services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

## **FasTracks**

**CB10-0699 A bill for an Ordinance approving a proposed Public Work West Corridor Right of Way Agreement (FasTracks West Corridor) between the City and County of Denver and the Regional Transportation District ("RTD") to provide for the transfer of properties to and from the City and County of Denver to and from the RTD for value specified for the purpose of furthering the FasTracks West Corridor Project. (FASTRACKS)**

Approves an intergovernmental agreement with the Regional Transportation District to transfer certain land located within the FasTracks West Corridor to facilitate completion of the transit line with the value of the City's transferred land to be credited as part of its local match obligation. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-19-10.

## **Finance**

**CB10-0637 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Harris Corporation for maintenance services for radios and equipment used throughout the City. (FINANCE)**

Approves a contract amendment to the Harris Corporation FX Services agreement to increase the contract \$308,000 for two years of maintenance services for radios and equipment used throughout the City through July 30, 2013 for a total contract amount of \$177,000 per year. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

## **General Government**

**CB10-0513 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement with West Publishing Corporation d/b/a Thomson West, to revise on-line legal research services. (GENERAL GOVERNMENT)**

Amends the contract with West Publishing Corporation, d/b/a Thomson West, to revise the online legal research access schedule and the print material discount schedule. The monthly guarantee rate will increase by \$200 effective 05/01/2010 and this rate will increase by 2% for each succeeding one year period through 04/30/2013. The cost increases are within the current cap amount (\$650,000) of this contract, so no monetary adjustment is required. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0651 A bill for an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service. (GENERAL GOVERNMENT)**

Approves the creation of two classifications - Enterprise Resource Planning Applications Administrator I and II for the Department of Technology Services. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**Public Amenities**

**CB10-0507 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Landtech Contractors, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends the on-call contract with Landtech Contractors regarding reference to M/WBE goals and commitments. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

**CB10-0626 A bill for an ordinance approving a First Amendment to a Cooperative Agreement with Civic Center Conservancy with regard to vendor services in Civic Center Park. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends the 2006 Civic Center Conservancy Cooperative Agreement to provide the Conservancy the ability to contract and manage vending in Civic Center Park in areas designated by DPR and within guidelines established by DPR; and authorizes the Conservancy to contract for additional maintenance. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-28-10.

**CB10-0636 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed User Agreement (Extension) between the City and County of Denver and Colorado Symphony Association. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Approves a first amendment to the sublease agreement for use of Boettcher Concert Hall at the Denver Performing Arts Complex by the Colorado Symphony Orchestra for total revenue in the amount of \$1,406,467 for a lease ending date on August 31, 2015. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

## **Public Works**

### **CB10-0635 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Master Purchase Order between the City and County of Denver and SunCor Energy USA, Incorporated, for asphalt binder oil. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a purchase from SunCor of asphalt binder oil used by the City asphalt plant in the production of hot mixed asphalt in the amount of \$3.3 million. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

### **CB10-0643 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Centennial Engineering, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a second amendment to the Centennial Engineering, Inc. on-call agreement to add one year with a two year option and a maximum amount per year not to exceed \$500,000 to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

### **CB10-0644 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between URS Corporation and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the on-call professional services agreement with URS Corporation for a one-year term with a two year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

### **CB10-0646 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Hartwig & Associates, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide services for traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the professional services agreement with Hartwig & Associates, Inc. for a one-year term with a two year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

### **CB10-0647 A bill for an ordinance approving the second amendatory on-call agreement between Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide traffic and transportation engineering services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an amendment to the professional services agreement with Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig, Inc. for a one-year term with a two-year option not to exceed \$500,000 annually. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.



**CB10-0657 A bill for an ordinance approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado - Department of Transportation for the State Senate Bill 8 - Traffic Control Device Maintenance Program. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with CDOT Region 6 for the State Senate Bill 8 - Traffic Control Device Maintenance program to receive and expend annual state funds in the amount of \$1,215,754.56 over five years for the annual maintenance of traffic signals, traffic signs, and pavement markings on state highways within the City and County of Denver. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-29-10.

**Safety**

**CB10-0623 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory agreement between Regents of the University of Colorado, d/b/a Addiction Research and Treatment (ARTS) and the City & County of Denver for Community Corrections program services. (SAFETY)**

Approves a \$258,987.19 supplemental contract with the University of Colorado Denver Addiction Research and Treatment Services (Peer I/Haven) for additional FY09-10 Community Corrections program services. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0627 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America, Federal Emergency Management Agency, concerning the "Incident Management Team Pilot FY10 " program and the funding therefor. (SAFETY)**

Accepts a \$500,000 grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the FY10-11 Incident Management Team Pilot Project. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0701 A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between FCI Constructors, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for Smith Road improvements to complete the final phase of the Denver Justice Center Project (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION, & SERVICES)**

Approves a \$22,522,000 contract with FCI Constructor's, Inc. for construction of the Denver Justice Center Smith Road East Detention Housing Unit Project. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-30-10. The bill was approved for filing by Councilman Hancock.

Changes the zoning of the 0.85-acre parcel at 4725 High from PUD #250 to PUD to allow addition of housing for female veterans and their children and services in the existing Elyria School building in Council District 9. **CB10-0631 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Contract between the City and County of Denver and Kiewit Building Group, Inc., for the construction of the new Eastside Human Services facility. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Approves a contract with Kiewit Building Group in the amount of \$10,873,892.55 for construction of the new Eastside Human Services facility located in Council District 8. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved this bill at its meeting on 7-26-10.

**CB10-0563 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Purchase Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Constellation Solar V, LLC related to a new solar plant at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves an up to \$16,000,000 agreement with Constellation Solar V, LLC to purchase power from its 4.5MWDC photovoltaic (PV) solar electricity generating system at DIA for up to 25 years at a rate of \$0.036/kWh or 80% of current rates with an option for the airport to buy the system at the beginning of the 7th year. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0564 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Loan Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Constellation Solar V, LLC related to a new solar plant at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves a \$7,500,000 loan agreement (at a rate of 5.5% for a term of 20 years) with Constellation Solar V, LLC to offset some costs of developing a 4.5MWDC photovoltaic (PV) solar electricity system to generate power for the airport on a long-term basis. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0565 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Ground Lease Agreement between City and County of Denver and Constellation Solar V, LLC related to leased space for a new solar plant at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Part of a three-agreement arrangement to facilitate the construction of a solar plant providing long-term, below-market electricity for the airport, this agreement approves a ground lease for Constellation Solar V, LLC to use 35 acres of DIA land to construct the plant. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0598 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Concession Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Continental Airlines, Inc., related to a food and beverage concession at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves a concession agreement for sale of food and beverages prepared in the Continental Airlines flight kitchen that provides revenue to the airport based on a percentage of sales. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0599 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement for DIA Enabling Construction Projects South Terminal Redevelopment Program Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) between the City and County of Denver and Kiewit Building Group, Inc. related to construction services at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves a \$50,000,000 contract with Kiewit Building Group for Construction Management/General Contractor services on the South Terminal Redevelopment Program with minority/women enterprise participation goals of 20%. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0612 A bill for an ordinance adding a new Division 5 to Chapter 20, Article IV, D.R.M.C., requiring certain city contractors to confirm the lawful employment status of their employees. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Requires additional city contractors to confirm the lawful employment status of their employees, and provides local procedures for enforcing this requirement. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0628 A bill for an ordinance approving a Fourth Amendment to Cooperative Service Agreement between the City and County of Denver and USDA-APHIS Wildlife Services to extend the contract for performing certain wildlife control measures at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Adds six months and \$186,024 to the agreement with United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Inspection Service, Wildlife Services to implement the airport's Wildlife Hazard Management Plan. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0617 A bill for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 329, Series of 2010, concerning the "Community Development Block Grant FY10" program, the "HOME FY10" program and the "HOPWA FY10" Program. (FINANCE)**

Approves amending the grant project numbers in Ordinance No. 329, Series 2010 to appropriately account for grant agreements associated with the CDBG FY10, HOME FY10, and HOPWA FY10 programs. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0625 A bill for an ordinance making rescissions of budget balances to close out grants, and transferring grant cash balances to the General Fund. (FINANCE)**

Approves zeroing out agency grant budgets totaling \$158,215.45 representing completed projects and transferring cash balances totaling \$3,731.85 to the General Fund. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0621 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Extension to Lease Agreement among the City and County of Denver, Recycled Materials Company, Inc., and Waste Management of Colorado, Inc., to extend the lease term and increase payment rates for use of the Denver Arapahoe Disposal Site for recycling operations. (GREENPRINT)**

Extends the current contract with Recycled Materials Company and Waste Management of Colorado to 2011 and increases payment rates for use of the Denver Arapahoe Disposal Site for their recycling operations. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0632 A bill for an ordinance amending Article IV of Chapter 48 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver regarding illegal dumping. (GREENPRINT)**

Revises terms and definitions and expands authority for administrative citations related to illegal dumping. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0633 A bill for an ordinance amending Article IV of Chapter 48 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver regarding illegal dumping and conforming changes to Chapters 12. (GREENPRINT)**

Sets administrative citation penalties for illegal dumping and provides for abatement procedures. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-21-10.

**CB10-0603 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Health and Human Services concerning the "Head Start FY10-11" program and the funding therefor. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)**

Accepts a grant in the amount of \$6,413,687 from U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services (GC01038) for head start services to 1,083 eligible children and families. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-15-10.

**CB10-0614 A bill for an ordinance approving a Third Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and HS2 Group LLC fna Express Personnel Inc. and aka Express Services Inc. and Express Employment Professionals LLC, to continue providing temporary employment for positions that would not normally be provided through the City's on-call temporary employment program. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)**

Approves a contract increase in the amount of \$400,000 to the HS2 Group LLC agreement (fna Express Personnel Inc., Express Services Inc., and Express Employment Professionals LLC) to provide temporary employment personnel services at the Department of Human Services for a term ending December 31, 2010. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0547 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed First Amendment to Sublease Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Center for the Performing Arts to extend the term of the current sublease agreement regarding the use of office space located at 1245 Champa Street. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Extends the contract with the Denver Performing Arts Complex for five years through Sept. 30, 2015 for office space at 1245 Champa for \$545,857.94. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 7-14-10.

**CB10-0620 A bill for an ordinance establishing a new article XI on donations, gifts, grants, and bequests in Chapter 39 (parks and recreation) of the Denver revised municipal code, to include a new section 39-221, regarding monetary contributions, donations, bequests, beneficiary earnings, private grants, and other cash gifts or endowments, and a new section 39-222, regarding gifts of personal property and certain improvements, all in accordance with Charter section 2.4.4(E). (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends Chapter 39 to allow Parks & Recreation to accept gifts, donations, grants and bequests of less than \$500,000 without an individual acceptance ordinance. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0618 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Third Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Community Mediation Concepts, for mediation services which are available to all City agencies. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an additional \$99,500 to complete the contract term through July 15, 2011, with Community Mediation Concepts, which is available to all City agencies. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0574 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed agreement between the City and County of Denver and Community Education Centers for residential and non-residential community corrections services. (SAFETY)**

Approves a \$ 2,028,514 contract with Community Education Centers for community corrections services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-23-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

**CB10-0616 A bill for an ordinance amending Section 14-123 of Article VI of Chapter 14 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver to establish new sheriff fees that conform with state law changes. (SAFETY)**

Approves fee increase for sheriffs' services to comply with new state law. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.

**CB10-0622 A bill for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 42, Series of 2008, concerning the "Secure Our Schools" Program. (SAFETY)**

Approves an ordinance to correct the stated match for the Federal Secure Our Schools grant by adding \$250. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-22-10.
