A BILL

For an ordinance to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvement and Capital Maintenance and State Conservation Trust Funds.

WHEREAS, rehabilitation funds are needed for the replacement of tennis courts at Berkley Lake Park and Eisenhower Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:


