**A BILL**

For an ordinance amending the setback requirements of designated consumption areas.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That section 6-311, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

6-311- Zoning, location, and setback requirements.

(a) A designated consumption area may not be located or operated within any of the following ~~one thousand (1,000) feet of any school~~, with the distance computed by direct measurement in a straight line from the nearest property line of the land used for ~~school~~ establishment to the nearest portion of the building, structure, or enclosure in which the designated consumption area is located:

- (1) One thousand (1,000) feet of any school;
- (2) Five hundred (500) feet of any Child Care Establishment;
- (3) Five hundred (500) feet of any alcohol or drug treatment facility;
- (4) Five hundred (500) feet of any city-owned recreation center or city-owned outdoor pools.

(b) A designated consumption area shall not require specific zoning permits, and shall be permitted in any zone lot where the underlying business or event is permitted.
