Business, Workforce & Sustainability

- BR12- Approves a contract with M'KNIB CO for the Comfort Dental Marketing 0468 Group with Arts & Venues Denver for \$500,000 in sponsorship/advertising rights at Red Rocks Amphitheatre (THTRS-201206288).
- BR12- Amends the lease agreement with Quiz-DIA to allow concessionaire to hold over on a month-to-month basis upon expiration of its term and continue providing service to the public at 100% of rental rate until a Request for Proposals can be issued (AC-39013-08) (ACON).
- BR12- Amends the City's medical marijuana code, due to delays in processing the applications submitted in August of 2010, to allow the Director of Excise & Licenses to issue optional premises cultivation licenses to applicants who were lawfully in the pipeline for approval under existing state and city laws when applications were submitted to the State and who meet all other requirements for licensing but which are now in compliant or non-conforming locations under the new zoning, since the current language requires such licenses to be issued by July 1, 2012.

Government & Finance

BR12- Approves a purchase order with Muzak, LLC in the amount of 0507 \$635,602.48 for the purchase, installation and testing of the performance audio systems for the Boettcher Concert Hall (THTRS-0000002823).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

RR12- A resolution approving the appointments of three arbitrators to the 0500 permanent panel of arbitrators created by City Council pursuant to Charter §§ 9.8.8(C) and 9.9.8(C).

- BR12- Accepts the Emergency Solutions Grant, provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), in the amount of \$687,541 to assist with emergency services for individuals in poverty for fiscal year 2012 (SOCSV-201206392).
- BR12- Accepts the 2012-2013 Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) issued by the State of Colorado-Department of Local Affairs in the amount of \$1,458,570 for poverty and homelessness programs.
- RR12- Approves a contract with Sierra Security System in the amount of \$1,222,330 for maintenance of the electronics equipment at the court house and the detention center facility through December 31, 2014 (SHERF-201103350-00).

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- BR12- Amends the contract with CH2M Hill to add \$3,713,516, for a new total of \$6,201,186, and extend the term by 4 years, through 2016, for the Peoria Grade Separation project Phase III, advanced engineering, procurement and support services during design and construction (201102842).
- BR12- Approves an InterGovernmental Agreement with Colorado Dept. of Transportation regarding \$1,224,000 in Federal Surface Transportation Improvement funds to reimburse the City for pedestrian improvements on Blake St. north and south of the bridge over 38th near the Platte River in Council Districts 8 and 9 (201205634).
- BR12- Approves a \$5,656,000 contract with Ash & White Construction Co. to construct the new, 27,000 square foot, LEED silver certified West Denver Library, a Better Denver Bond project at Colfax and Irving in Council District 1 (201204517).

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
