 - a. Scope of Work**

This ordinance will authorize 25% of the appropriation of the 2013-2014 funding for Continuum of Care (formerly Shelter Plus Care)-Anchor to provide 12 units of sponsor based rental assistance for the Anchor project to help chronically homeless individuals with mental illnesses obtain and remain in housing. Based on the Letter of Intent, the award amount will total \$111,650 beginning June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2013. In order to ensure program continuity, DDHS is requesting an appropriation of \$27,912.50.

This ordinance will authorize 25% of the appropriation of the 2013-2014 funding for Continuum of Care (formerly Shelter Plus Care)-Anchor to provide 12 units of sponsor based rental assistance for the Anchor project to help chronically homeless individuals with mental illnesses obtain and remain in housing. Based on the Letter of Intent, the award amount will total \$111,650 beginning June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2013. In order to ensure program continuity, DDHS is requesting an appropriation of \$27,912.50.
