**A BILL**

**For an ordinance approving a resolution requesting the renewal and extension of the RiNo Business Improvement District for an additional ten-year period.**

**WHEREAS**, the RiNo Business Improvement District (the “District”) was initiated by petition filed with the City Clerk, ex-officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk File No. 2015-0200, and was created and established pursuant to Ordinance No. 304, Series of 2015 (“Creation Ordinance”); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Creation Ordinance directs that:

*“The [Board of Directors of the District (“Board”)] will provide notice and conduct a public hearing during the ninth year of the District’s existence to obtain property owner comments on the District’s effectiveness and success. If the District is deemed successful, the Board will request that the City Council renew the District by giving public notice, holding a hearing, and adopting an ordinance prior to the end of the ten-year initial term. If the District is not considered to be successful, it will sunset at the end of the initial term and terminate after it has wound up its affairs. This process will repeat every ten (10) years.”*

; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board held a public hearing on extending the District’s term on November 13, 2024, and thereafter adopted a resolution determining, among other things, that the District has been successful and should be extended for another ten (10) year term (the “Renewal Resolution”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Renewal Resolution has been filed with the City Clerk, ex-officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk Filing No. 20250003 on January 8, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Renewal Resolution satisfies the threshold required by the Creation Ordinance that the District has been successful over the prior ten-year period and demonstrates support for the renewal and extension of the District for another ten-year period.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The Renewal Resolution satisfies the threshold established by the Creation Ordinance that the District has been successful over the prior ten-year period and demonstrates

1 support for the renewal and extension of the District for another ten-year term, which shall run  
2 through December 31, 2035 (the "Renewal Term").

3 **Section 2.** The City Council hereby approves the renewal and extension of the District for  
4 the Renewal Term and upon its conclusion, unless it is otherwise renewed and extended, the District  
5 shall sunset and dissolve in accordance the Creation Ordinance and with C.R.S. § 31-25-1225, as  
6 may be amended from time to time. The District may seek the City Council's consent for the District's  
7 further renewal and extension for a subsequent ten-year term prior to the end of the Renewal Term  
8 in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Creation Ordinance and as further described  
9 herein.
