City Council, as ex-officio Board of Directors, approves the GID’s annual Work Plan and Budget including Capital and Maintenance Charges by Resolution of the GID (not acting as City Council.). An advisory board consisting of the City Staff and District representatives recommends the work plan and budget, including Capital and Maintenance Charges to the Board of Directors.

All required public hearings are held by the 14<sup>th</sup> St. District Advisory board instead of the Board of Directors as directed by the 14<sup>th</sup> St GID Creation Ordinance. Therefore, there is no need for any announcement of a public hearing at the board level or publication of a public hearing at the Board level or holding a hearing at the Board level. There are no mill levies or assessments, just capital and maintenance charges.
