

A parcel of land located in Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and part of Lots 10, 38, 39 and 40, in Block 12 of the Sherman Subdivision, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 12, of said Sherman Subdivision; thence south along the west boundary of said Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. 107 feet; thence on a deflection angle to the left 90°00'00" along a line 7 feet south and parallel to the north line of said Lot 10, 92 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the left 79.33 feet which is tangent to said last line. Said curve has a radius of 50.5 feet and a delta of 90°00'00"; thence north along a line parallel to the east line of said Lot 7, 1.5 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the left 23.79 feet which is tangent of said last line. Said curve has a radius of 50.5 feet and a delta of 26°59'23", to a point on the east right-of-way of a 12 foot wide alley; thence north along said right-of-way 32.08 feet; thence on a deflection angle to the left 90°00'00", 12 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 5; thence along the south line of said Lot 5, 125 feet to the point of beginning. Except the 12 foot wide alley that runs through the above described parcel in a north-south direction east of Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Block 12 of said Sherman Subdivision. #### RESOLUTION 1963

WHEREAS, The City and County of Denver desires to provide a cul-de-sac on South Grant Street between Louisiana Avenue and Arizona Avenue and has asked the School District to convey to it sufficient property on the Thatcher-McKinley site as part of the right-of-way of said cul-de-sac, and

WHEREAS, In the opinion of the Board of Education, it would be desirable to have a cul-de-sac on Grant Street between Louisiana Avenue and Arizona Avenue, and

WHEREAS, The City and County of Denver has indicated its intention to vacate South Grant Street between the southerly boundary of said cul-de-sac and Louisiana Avenue,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Education of School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, that the following described property be conveyed to the City and County of Denver for street purposes:

A parcel of land located in Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and part of Lots 10, 38, 39 and 40, in Block 12 of the Sherman Subdivision, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 12, of said Sherman Subdivision; thence south along the vest boundary of said Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, 107 feet; thence on a deflection angle to the left of 90°00°00° along a line 7 feet south and parallel to the north line of said Lot 10, 92 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the left 79.33 feet which is tangent to said last line. Said curve has a radius of 50.5 feet and a delta of 90°00°00°; thence north along a line parallel to the east line of said Lot 7, 1.5 feet;

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thence along an arc of a curve to the left 23.79 feet which is tangent of said last line. Said curve has a radius of 50.5 feet and a delta of 26°59'23", to a point on the east right-of-way of a 12 foot wide alley; thence north along said right-of-way 32.08 feet; thence on a deflection angle to the left 90°00'00", 12 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 5, thence along the south line of said Lot 5, 125 feet to the point of beginning, except the 12 foot wide alley that runs through the above described parcel in a north-south direction east of Lots 6.7.8, 9 and 10 of Block 12 of said Sherman Subdivision. Said parcel of land containing 0.30 acres, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED. That the appropriate officers of the School District be and they hereby are authorized and empowered to execute a deed in appropriate form conveying such real property to the City and County of Denver after such vacation of South Grant Street.

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
