A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to award grant funding for capital equipment.

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) has sent a letter stating their intent to provide grant funds to the Denver Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent to fund, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 14-0401;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire a new Blood Alcohol Testing (BAT) vehicle.

Section 2. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

Authorization for expenditures will cover the period from June 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. The foregoing authorization is for 100% of the amount indicated in the Letter of Intent (LOI) to Fund from the Colorado Department of Transportation.

2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
