A resolution making appointments and reappointments to the Denver County Cultural Council.

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statute 32-13-103(3) provides for the appointment of a county cultural council by the Denver City Council to provide for the distribution of Tier III revenues as required by the Denver Metropolitan Scientific and Cultural Facilities District; and

WHEREAS, the eleven-member Denver County Cultural Council has been established by the City Council to institute procedures for the application and determination of the distribution of Tier III funding; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance establishing the Denver County Cultural Council requires the appointment of eight members by the City Council for staggered terms of two, three, and four years and three members representing Denver Arts & Venues, Visit Denver, and Denver Public Schools, each for two-year terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

SECTION 1. That the Council hereby reappoints Patricia Hunt and Dan Reagan for terms ending October 1, 2016; appoints William Chan and reappoints Lee Gash-Maxey for terms ending October 1, 2017; and reappoints Don Eberle for a term that ends October 1, 2018.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this resolution and that copies hereof be transmitted to the Denver County Cultural Council.
