**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making an appropriation in the Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund and authorizing a cash transfer to the General Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund, Fund No. 12302, has cash balances from unused State contract dollars from the FY15-16 contract year to the FY17-18 contract year totaling \$110,652; and

**WHEREAS**, such balances arise due to funds allocated by the State for the City’s administration of the Community Corrections program that remain unspent; and

**WHEREAS**, such cash balances have historically been transferred to the General Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the 2020 budget process, the Executive Director of Safety’s Office requested to transfer the balance to the General Fund to support 2020 budget capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Adopted Budget assumes the General Fund will receive the \$110,652 in cash transfer revenue from the Community Corrections SRF; however, the appropriation for the cash transfer in the SRF was omitted from the 2020 Budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1193, Series of 2019, there is hereby appropriated in 2020 to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
