For an ordinance adding Article III to Chapter 55, of the Revised Municipal Code, creating a Vehicle Identification Number Verification Service and Fee in the City and County of Denver.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 55-61 is hereby added to Chapter 55 of the Revised Municipal Code allowing for the creation of a vehicle identification number verification service and fee in the City and County of Denver, to read as follows:

ARTICLE III. INSPECTION SERVICES.

Section 55-61. Vehicle Identification Number Inspection Services.

The Vehicle Impoundment Facility of the Denver Sheriff's Department shall offer two Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) services to the public, for the convenience of the public, to assist with the registration and titling of vehicles:

(1) A VIN verification for out of state vehicles needing to be registered in Colorado shall be performed for a \$25 per vehicle charge.

(2) A Certified VIN inspection shall be performed for a cost of \$45 per vehicle for the first hour of inspection, or fraction thereof, and \$20 for each additional half hour that is required to perform the inspection on a vehicle.
