



Committee Consent Agenda

Business, Workforce & Sustainability

- BR12- Approves a contract with touchPoint Partners (TPP) (THTRS-201205232) to develop a marketing program for local sustainable businesses at a discounted rate for City inventory (such as booth space at Red Rocks) with the City receiving 50% of additional private sponsorships that TPP obtains for the program.
- BR12- Adds \$1 million to the contract with CenturyLink (CE15006) for on-call technical systems support including analytic services, project management services, infrastructure services, voice and data network services and operations systems design and implementation for the airport.
- BR12- Approves an 18-month no-cost extension for the contract with Woolpert (# CE92068) to develop a new datum and coordinate system as required by the Federal Aviation Agency for the airport.
- BR12- Approves a revenue contract with MillerCoors (THTRS-201205437) for the exclusive malt beverage advertising rights and certain signage rights for Red Rocks Amphitheatre, the Denver Coliseum, Boettcher Concert Hall, the Buell Theatre, the Newton Auditorium/Ellie Caulkins Opera House and the Colorado Convention Center for revenue of \$675,000 over three years.

Government & Finance

- BR12- Abolishes Public Safety Inspector (621-T) and creates the following new classes: Combination Inspector I (622-T), Combination Inspector II (624-T), Chief Combination Inspector (812-T) and Trades Inspector (621-T) as Career Service job classifications.
- BR12- Adds \$710,000 to the Master Purchase Order with Wagner Equipment Company for OEM Caterpillar™ Heavy Equipment parts and components.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR12- Approves a proposed grant agreement and expenditures to the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) contract concerning the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) FY2012 program (G12RM0018A) funding in the amount of \$951,119 to be used for three public safety initiatives, staffing, and equipment.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

BR12- Vacates a portion of right of way at the corner of W. 32nd Ave and a cross alley near Tejon Street in Council District 9.

BR12- Approves a \$700,000 contract with AECOM Technical Services with a term through 6-30-14 to complete an assessment of the Focus model under a \$2 million Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Alternatives Analysis Grant for the East Colfax Corridor in Council Districts 5, 8 and 10. (PWADM-201205425)

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
