The purpose of this contract agreement is to provide a DDPHE award for \$999,900. These funds will be provided to Denver Health and Hospital Authority (DHHA) to be utilized to support and strengthen existing internal infrastructure focused on partnerships with Denver homelessness resolution partners and the Roads to Recovery project to better align housing and health supports for some of the most at-risk persons experiencing homelessness (PEH) utilizing the hospital system, including those with criminal justice involvement who are part of Roads to Recovery program.
