A BILL

For an ordinance amending Chapter 42 of the Revised Municipal Code to establish the 2013 and 2014 salaries of the Police Chief, Deputy Chiefs, Division Chiefs and Commanders.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That effective January 1, 2013, Chapter 42, Article II, Division 3, Section 42-53 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 42-53. Same---Police chief, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders.

(a) Effective ~~December 18, 2011~~ **January 1, 2013**, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

(b) Effective ~~July 1, 2012~~ **January 1, 2014**, the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:

~~(c) Pay schedule. As provided in Section 18-11, the city is authorized to implement a lag payroll system for the chief of police, deputy chiefs, division chiefs, and commanders. Except as otherwise provided in section 18-11 and in this division 3 of article II, every such employee shall be paid biweekly at a biweekly rate arrived at by dividing the annual rate set forth in the pay plan for the pay grade applicable to the class to which the position is allocated by the biweekly periods for the calendar year.~~
