

## Proclamation No. CP14-0366

In recognition of Día del Niño, April 27, 2014

WHEREAS, on November 20, 1959 the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Declaration of the Rights of the Child, which outlines that every child has the right to protection, health care, shelter, good nutrition, and education; and

**WHEREAS**, seven of Denver's top cultural institutions have banded together to host this year's thirteenth annual "Día del Niño" to celebrate young children throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Art Museum, the Byers-Evans House Museum, the Clyfford Still Museum, the Molly Brown House Museum, the Denver Public Library, the McNichols Building and History Colorado, in partnership with the Consulate General of Mexico, the Mexican Cultural Center and the Denver Art Museum's Latino Outreach Committee will be offering creative activities for the whole family including kids dance performances, art projects, bilingual tours, and live artists leading activities; and

**WHEREAS,** Día del Niño is an opportunity for all members of the community to celebrate the beauty of children and to experience and explore the City's cultural complex with interactive family friendly programming at the City's sponsoring cultural institutions; and

**WHEREAS**, these institutions recognize the value of inspiring creativity in children to celebrate this special day and will be offering free admission.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER THAT:

**Section 1.** The Council hereby proclaims April 27, 2014 as "Dia del Niño" in the City and County of Denver and urges families to participate in the festivities at the City's sponsoring cultural institutions.

**Section 2.** That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to Kristy Bassuener. Denver Art Museum.
