  - a. Scope of Work
    This ordinance will authorize Public Works to enter into a contract with Transwest to
    acquire three (3) aerial bucket trucks. A total of 4 aerial bucket trucks will be acquired
    however, no ordinance is required for the forth hybrid aerial bucket truck because its
    being acquired from a different vendor, OJ Watson, and the cost of the vehicle is less
    than \$500,000. The total cost of the Transwest aerial bucket trucks is \$518,495. A
    companion lease purchase agreement with All American Investment Group (AAIG) will
    provide financing for all 4 vehicles whose combined cost is \$747,700. The vehicles are
