**A BILL**

**For an ordinance approving a proposed donation of a surplus property Historical NOVA Police Vehicle from the City and County of Denver to the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc.**

**WHEREAS**, the City owns a 1978 Chevrolet NOVA Show Car; currently housed and maintained by the Denver Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle holds historical and sentimental value, and has long served as an effective community outreach tool; and

**WHEREAS**, due to increasing maintenance needs and rising costs, the Historical NOVA Police Vehicle would be better preserved and more effectively utilized under the care of the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc. is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to strengthening community understanding, educating youth, and promoting social impact by building bridges between community members and law enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc. has already financially contributed towards the maintenance of the Historical NOVA Police Vehicle and has expressed strong interest in assuming full ownership; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc. is well-positioned to manage the vehicle's long-term care, preservation, and continued use at community events; and

**WHEREAS**, donating the Historical NOVA Police Vehicle aligns with the City and the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc. shared goals of honoring the history of the Denver Police Department while continuing to build trust through meaningful outreach; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed donation of a surplus property Historical NOVA Police Vehicle from the City and County of Denver to the Denver Police Law Enforcement Museum, Inc. cannot be made until after the approval by the Council of the City in accordance with subsection 2.9.3(C), Part 9, of Article II of the Charter of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has determined that the Historical NOVA Police Vehicle is surplus and the donation is in the best interests of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has duly reviewed and approved the proposed donation.
